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Implementation progress of RCEP

RCEP will come into effect in Korea on February 1st next year

On December 6th, according to the Ministry of Industry, Trade and Resources of the Republic of Korea, the Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (RCEP) will officially come into force for South Korea on February 1st next year after being approved by the South Korean National Assembly and reported to the ASEAN Secretariat. South Korea's National Assembly approved the agreement on the 2nd of this month, and then the ASEAN Secretariat reported that the agreement would come into effect for South Korea in 60 days, that is, next February.

As the largest free trade agreement in the world, South Korea's exports to RCEP members account for about half of South Korea's total exports. After the agreement comes into effect, South Korea will also establish bilateral free trade relations with Japan for the first time.



Implementation progress of RCEP

China's customs has announced the detailed implementation rules and matters needing attention in declaration

Measures of the Customs of the People's Republic of China for the Administration of the Origin of Import and Export Goods under the Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (Order No.255 of the General Administration of Customs)

China will implement it as of January 1, 2022. The announcement clarifies the RCEP rules of origin, the conditions that the certificate of origin needs to meet, and the procedures for enjoying imported goods in China.

Administrative Measures of the Customs of the People's Republic of China on Approved Exporters (Order No.254 of the General Administration of Customs)

It will come into force as of January 1, 2022. Establish an information system for the management of approved exporters by the Customs to improve the management facilitation level of approved exporters. An enterprise applying to become an approved exporter shall submit a written application to the customs directly under its domicile (hereinafter referred to as the competent customs). The validity period recognized by the approved exporter is 3 years. Before the approved exporter issues a declaration of origin for the goods it exports or produces, it shall submit the Chinese and English names of the goods, the six-digit codes of the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System, applicable preferential trade agreements and other information to the competent customs. The approved exporter shall issue a declaration of origin through the customs approved exporter management information system, and be responsible for the authenticity and accuracy of the declaration of origin issued by him.

Announcement No.106 of General Administration of Customs in 2021 (Announcement on the Implementation of Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement)

It came into effect and implemented on January 1, 2022. At the time of import declaration, fill in the Customs Declaration Form for Import (Export) Goods of the People's Republic of China and submit the documents of origin according to the relevant requirements of Announcement No.34 of General Administration of Customs in 2021 on "Imported goods under preferential trade agreements with electronic information exchange of origin". The preferential trade agreement code of the Agreement is "22". When the importer fills in the electronic data of the certificate of origin through the Declaration System of Origin Elements of Preferential Trade Agreement, if the column "Country of origin (region) under the Agreement" of the certificate of origin contains "" or "* *", the column "Country of origin under the Preferential Trade Agreement" should correspondingly fill in "Unknown origin (according to the highest tax rate of relevant members)" or "Unknown origin (according to the highest tax rate of all members)". Before the export declaration, the applicant can apply to China's visa agencies such as the Customs, China Council for the Promotion of International Trade and its local branches for issuing the certificate of origin under the Agreement. If the back-to-back certificate of origin is issued, and the electronic data of the initial certificate of origin is not filled in through the "Declaration System of the Elements of Origin of Preferential Trade Agreement" when the goods enter the country, the applicant of the certificate of origin or the approved exporter shall supplement it. For goods in transit, you can first apply to the customs for the declaration of origin qualification, and submit a valid certificate of origin to the customs before June 30, 2021.

RCEP tariff concession arrangement

"Uniform tariff concessions" and "Country-specific tariff concessions"

- Eight countries adopted "unified tariff reduction": Australia, New Zealand, Brunei, Cambodia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar and Singapore. That is, the same product originated from different parties under RCEP will be subject to the same tax rate when imported by the above parties;
- Seven countries have adopted "country-specific tariff concessions": China, Japan, South Korea, Indonesia, Philippines, Thailand and Vietnam. This means that the same product originating from different contracting parties is subject to different RCEP agreement tax rates when imported. China has made tariff commitments on goods trade with Japan, South Korea, Australia, New Zealand and ASEAN, with five tariff commitments.

Time of enjoying RCEP agreement tax rate

Tariff reduction time is different

- Except Indonesia, Japan and the Philippines, which cut tariffs on April 1st every year, the other 12 contracting parties cut tariffs on January 1st every year.

Subject to the current tariff

- The tariff schedule of RCEP Agreement is a legally effective achievement finally reached based on the 2014 tariff.

Subject to the current tariff

- In practice, based on the commodity classification of the current year's tariff, the agreed tariff schedule is transformed into results.

Subject to the current tariff

- The agreed tax rate of each final product in the current year shall be subject to the corresponding agreed tax rate published in the tariff of the current year.

Summary of emergency preventive measures in December



India

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive in an inner package sample of a batch of frozen hairtail imported from India, according to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs suspended accepting the import declaration of Indian aquatic product manufacturer M/s. Siddiq sea food unit II (registration number: 1173) for one week from November 26th.



Thailand

Due to the positive detection of Covid-19 nucleic acid in an outer packaging sample of a batch of frozen black tiger shrimp imported from Thailand, according to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs suspended the import declaration of products from Golden Seafood International Co., Ltd. (registration number: 1328), a Thai aquatic product manufacturer, for one week from November 26th.



Argentina

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive in an outer packaging sample of a batch of frozen Argentine red shrimp imported from Argentina, according to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs suspended the import declaration of products from the Argentine aquatic product manufacturer Conarpesa (registered as 2267) for one week from November 30th.



Russia

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive in an outer packaging sample of a batch of frozen fine-scale salmon imported from Russia, according to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs suspended the import declaration of Russian aquatic product manufacturer Matsky LTD Fish processing plant (registration number: CH-965) for one week from December 7th.

Summary of emergency preventive measures in December



Myanmar

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive in two outer packaging samples of a batch of frozen hairtail imported from Myanmar, according to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs suspended the import declaration of Myanmar aquatic products manufacturer Ocean World Coldstore (registration number YGN/132/OW/DOF) for four weeks from December 8th.



India

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive in one package and one product body sample of a batch of frozen South American white shrimp imported from India, according to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs suspended the import declaration of products from Indian aquatic product manufacturer M/S. Shankha Deep Exports PVT.Ltd. (registration number: 487) for one week from December 9th.



Viet Nam

Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive in two outer packaging samples of a batch of frozen dried chicken and fish from Vietnam, and Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive in three outer packaging samples of a batch of frozen dried squid. According to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, Since December 10th, the national customs has suspended the import declaration of Vietnamese aquatic products manufacturers A Chau Hoa Thanh Company Limited (registered number HK 158) and BH CO.,LTD (registered number HK 761) for one week.



Russia

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive in an outer packaging sample of a batch of frozen Pacific cod imported from Russia, according to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs suspended the import declaration of products from Russian processing fishing boat Kapitan Eremov JSC "Yuzhmorrybflot" (registration number: CH-155) for one week from December 11th.

Indonesia

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive in an outer packaging sample of a batch of frozen cuttlefish imported from Indonesia, according to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs suspended the import declaration of Indonesian aquatic product manufacturer PT. SUMBER SAMUDERA INDONESIA (registration number: CR 750-14) for one week from December 16th.



India

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive in a product body sample of a batch of frozen snails imported from India, according to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs suspended the import declaration of products from Indian aquatic product manufacturer M/S. Esmario Export Enterprises Private Limited (registration number 528) for one week from December 16th.



India

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive in one outer packaging sample of a batch of frozen South American white shrimp imported from India, according to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs suspended the import declaration of Indian aquatic products manufacturer SINGERY MARINES PVT LTD (registration number: 1332) for one week from December 17th.



Viet Nam

Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive in one outer packaging sample of a batch of frozen Basha fish fillet imported from Vietnam, and Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive in one outer packaging sample of a batch of frozen dried squid. According to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, Since December 21st, the national customs has suspended the acceptance of Vietnamese aquatic products manufacturers I.D.I International Development and Investment Corporation (registered as DL 479) and Branch of Blue Sea Agriculture & Import declaration of products of Foods Processing Limited Company in Binh Thuan (Blue Sea Co., Ltd.) (registered as HK 780) for one week.



India

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive in one outer package sample and one inner package sample of a batch of frozen hairtail imported from India, according to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs suspended the import declaration of products from Indian aquatic product manufacturer M/S. Essex Marine PVT.Ltd. (registration number: 1315) for one week from December 23rd.

Animal and plant product supervision	Announcement of Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs of General Administration of Customs No.99, 2021	Announcement on preventing the introduction of Norwegian highly pathogenic avian influenza into China. From November 24th, 2021, it is forbidden to import poultry and related products directly or indirectly from Norway, including products from poultry that are unprocessed or processed but may still spread diseases. Once found, it will be returned or destroyed.
	Announcement No.98 of the General Administration of Customs in 2021	Announcement on inspection and quarantine requirements for imported Polish flour. Since November 26th, 2021, Polish flour that meets the inspection and quarantine requirements is allowed to be imported. The scope of access is wheat (<i>Triticum aestivum</i> L.) produced in Poland (including spelt wheat <i>Triticum aestivum</i> ssp. <i>spelta</i>) or rye (<i>secale cereal</i> L.) processed in Poland and exported to China. The announcement regulates the requirements of production enterprises, plant quarantine requirements, production requirements, food safety requirements, packaging requirements, vehicle quarantine requirements and plant quarantine certificate requirements.
	Announcement No.96 of the General Administration of Customs in 2021	Announcement on inspection and quarantine requirements for imported frozen fruits from Central and Eastern European countries. From February 1st, 2022, the import of frozen fruits from Central and Eastern European countries that meet the inspection and quarantine requirements will be allowed. The Central and Eastern European countries that export frozen fruits to China include Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, North Macedonia, Montenegro, Romania, Poland, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia and Greece. Frozen fruit refers to the fruit that has been frozen at -18 C or below for not less than 30 minutes after removing the inedible peel and stone, and is stored and transported at -18 C or below, and meets the requirements of the International Food Standard "Operational Code for the Processing and Treatment of Frozen Foods" (CAC/RCP 8-1976). The announcement regulates the requirements of processing plants and quick-freezing processing equipment, pre-export requirements and entry inspection and quarantine requirements.

Animal and plant product supervision	Announcement No.95 of the General Administration of Customs in 2021	Announcement on quarantine requirements of lemon plants imported from Uzbekistan. From November 22nd, 2021, Uzbekistan lemons that meet relevant requirements are allowed to be imported. The access scope is Lemon (scientific name Citrus limon, English name lemon) produced in Uzbekistan lemon producing area. The announcement regulates the requirements of orchards and packaging plants, quarantine pests, pre-export requirements, entry inspection and quarantine and unqualified disposal requirements, retrospective review requirements, etc.
	Announcement No.94 of the General Administration of Customs in 2021	Announcement on strengthening supervision and management of means of transport from animal epidemic areas. The announcement will be implemented as of November 22, 2021. It is required that the person in charge of transportation should earnestly fulfill the main responsibility of biosafety, and accurately fill in the information of living animals, animal and plant wastes and swill to be unloaded.
	Announcement No.93 of the General Administration of Customs in 2021	Announcement on inspection and quarantine requirements of imported Cuban wild aquatic products. From November 22nd, 2021, Cuban wild aquatic products that meet relevant requirements will be allowed to be imported. Wild aquatic products refer to wild aquatic animal products and their products for human consumption, marine plant products and their products such as algae, excluding the species listed in the appendix of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) and the list of wildlife under special state protection in China, live aquatic animals and aquatic animal and plant propagation materials. The announcement regulates the requirements of production enterprises, imported products, certificates, packaging and labeling, storage and transportation, etc.
	Announcement No.92 of the General Administration of Customs in 2021	Announcement on inspection and quarantine requirements for imported Cuban aquaculture products. From November 22nd, 2021, Cuban aquaculture products that meet relevant requirements are allowed to be imported. Aquaculture aquatic products refer to artificially cultured aquatic animal products and their products for human consumption, marine plant products and their products such as algae, excluding the species listed in the appendix of CITES and the list of wildlife under special state protection in China, live aquatic animals and aquatic animal and plant propagation materials. The announcement regulates the requirements of production enterprises, imported products, quarantine approval, certificates, packaging and labeling, storage and transportation, etc.

Animal and plant product supervision	Announcement No.91 of the General Administration of Customs in 2021	Announcement on preventing the introduction of tomato brown wrinkle virus with tomato and capsicum seeds. Since January 1st, 2022, the supervision of whether tomato and capsicum seeds carry tomato brown wrinkle virus will be strengthened. For the contents of the plant inspection and quarantine certificate issued by the exporter, if it is found that the certificate does not meet the requirements or tomato brown wrinkle virus is detected in the import process, it shall be returned or destroyed according to law.
Customs clearance supervision	Shanghai Customs (Notice on Clarifying Matters Related to Inspection of Imported Motor Vehicles) has made it clear that Shanghai Customs will not designate motor vehicle inspection agencies in any form	The consignor and consignee of imported motor vehicles or their agents can freely choose and entrust the inspection institutions that have obtained the qualification certification of inspection and testing institutions and the motor vehicle inspection capability recognized by China National Accreditation Council for Conformity Assessment (CNAS) to carry out inspection and test and issue inspection results. For the imported cars that leave the supervision area through two-stage access "conditional lifting and leaving" mode, it is necessary to explain the vehicle flow direction and storage location.

	Announcement No.103 of the General Administration of Customs in 2021	Announcement on issues related to the implementation of the Regulations of the People's Republic of China on the Registration of Overseas Production Enterprises of Imported Foods and the Measures of the People's Republic of China on the Safety Management of Import and Export Foods. The announcement explains the registration inquiry and application of overseas food production enterprises, product number inquiry, enterprise registration guide, declaration at the time of import, number marking, registration validity period and cost.
	Announcement No.101 of the General Administration of Customs in 2021	Announcement on authorizing customs directly under the central government to carry out quarantine examination and approval of some imported animals and plants and their products. Since December 6, 2021, the General Administration of Customs has authorized 28 directly affiliated customs to have the final approval authority for some animal and plant quarantine, and the products include plant and ornamental aquatic animals, edible aquatic animals, animal genetic material, non-edible animal products, feed, biological materials, fruits, tobacco leaves, etc. The whole process of quarantine examination and approval can be completed in the customs directly under the customs, with fewer examination and approval links, more than half of the examination and approval time, and greatly shortened examination and approval time.
