Reminder of enterprise annual report

Reminder of enterprise annual report



Legal ground

- Article 15 of the Administrative Measures of the Customs of the People's Republic of China on Tax Reduction and Exemption of Import and Export Goods
- Within the period of customs supervision, the applicant for tax reduction or exemption shall submit the Report on the Usage of Tax Reduction or Exemption Goods (hereinafter referred to as the "Annual Tax Reduction or Exemption Report") to the competent customs before June 30th of each year (inclusive) to report the usage of tax reduction or exemption goods.



Reporting requirements for tax reduction and exemption annual report

- Time requirement: The annual tax reduction and exemption report is filed once a year, and the filing time is from January 1st to June 30th (inclusive).



Reporting requirements for tax reduction and exemption annual report

- Requirements: The applicant for tax reduction or exemption shall report the usage status of tax reduction or exemption goods within the period of customs supervision. Unless otherwise stipulated by the General Administration of Customs, the supervision period of imported goods with tax reduction or exemption is: 8 years for ships and aircraft; Motor vehicle for 6 years; Other goods for 3 years.
- Within the above-mentioned years, it is required to declare to the customs every year according to the time requirement.

Reporting requirements for tax reduction and exemption annual report

- Declaration content requirements: The enterprise shall truthfully fill in the specific information according to the report content of the annual report on the use of duty-free goods.
- Note: During the period of customs supervision and within the next three years, the customs shall inspect the import and use of duty-reduced or exempted goods by relevant enterprises and units in accordance with the Customs Law of the People's Republic of China, Regulations of the People's Republic of China on Customs Inspection and other relevant regulations. The enterprise shall ensure the truthfulness and accuracy when reporting the annual report.



Matters needing attention in annual tax reduction and exemption report

Declaration method: online and offline

•The applicant for tax reduction or exemption can submit the annual report through the "Single Window of International Trade" or the "Follow-up of Tax Reduction or Exemption" function module of internet plus Customs, and the import enterprises of tax reduction or exemption goods registered with the customs can also declare through the "Declaration Information" module of the National Enterprise Credit Information Publicity System.

•After submitting the annual report application online through the above-mentioned system, the applicant for tax reduction or exemption should submit the following paper materials to the competent customs: the report on the use of tax reduction or exemption goods and the annual report on the use of tax reduction or exemption goods; If there is any change in the related information of tax-exempt goods, the table of changes in the use of tax-exempt goods, the table of changes in the actual import of tax-exempt goods, the table of changes in tax-exempt applicants, and the table of changes in the fixed assets or registration management of tax-exempt goods according to regulations should also be submitted.

Consequences of violation

•If the annual tax reduction or exemption report is not submitted within the prescribed time limit, the customs will list it in the abnormal list of credit information according to relevant regulations.

•The customs will not accept the application to the customs for tax reduction and exemption verification, tax guarantee for tax reduction and exemption goods, follow-up management of tax reduction and exemption goods and other related businesses.



Matters needing attention in reporting the annual report of cosmetics enterprises



Legal ground

State Food and Drug Administration

- Announcement on the implementation of the Regulations on the Management of Cosmetics Registration and Filing Data (No.35, 2021)

Time requirement and method of declaration

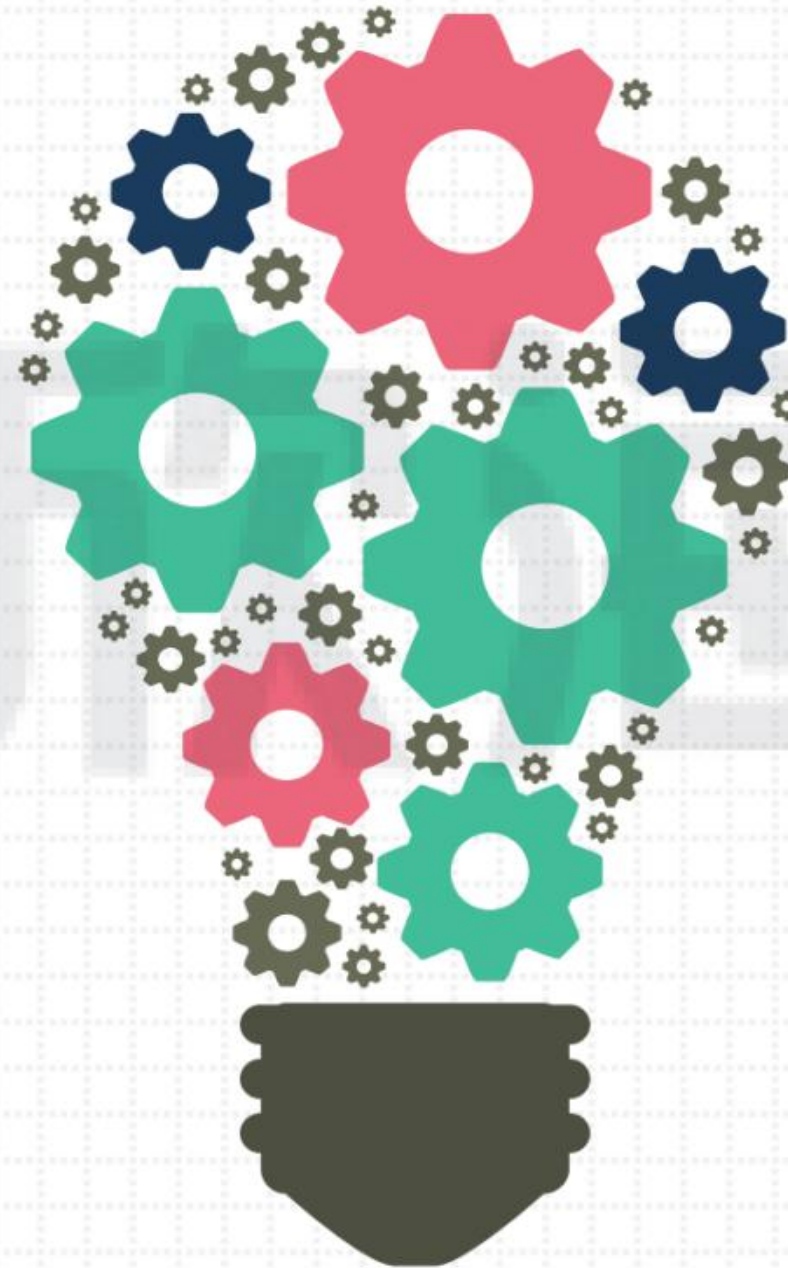
- Since January 1, 2022, the annual report system has been uniformly implemented for ordinary cosmetics filed through the original registration and filing platform and the new registration and filing platform.
- The filer shall submit the annual report of ordinary cosmetics for one year through the new registration and filing platform from January 1st to March 31st every year.
- Login website: National integrated online government service platform, online service hall of State Food and Drug Administration (<https://zfwf.nmpa.gov.cn>)

Matters needing attention in reporting the annual report of cosmetics enterprises



Transition of old filing platform

For cosmetics that have been registered or filed in the original registration and filing platform, registrants and filers should submit product implementation standards and sample product labels, fill in the product formula of domestic ordinary cosmetics, and upload label pictures of special cosmetics sales packaging through the new registration and filing platform before May 1, 2022.



Consequences of violation

If the enterprise fails to submit the annual report according to the regulations as scheduled, the drug administration department will give the enterprise a chance to make corrections. After receiving the correction opinions, the enterprise should make corrections in time and submit the annual report, otherwise the product will be cancelled for filing.

Summary of emergency preventive measures in March

India

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from 9 outer packages and 1 inner package sample of 3 batches of frozen hairtail imported from India and 1 outer package sample of 1 batch of frozen tongue sole, according to the regulation of General Administration of Customs Announcement No.103 of 2020, Since February 25, the national customs has suspended the acceptance of the product import declaration of two Indian aquatic product manufacturers, M/s. Rahemat Fish Centre (registrationNo. MUM/FFP/02565) and M/s. Zenith Exports (registration No.1280), for one week and one Indian aquatic product manufacturer, M/s. Pesca Marine Products Pvt. Ltd (registration No.1164), for two weeks.

Vietnam

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from one product body sample of one batch of frozen cuttlefish dried imported from Vietnam, two outer packaging samples of two batches of frozen squid dried and one outer packaging sample of one batch of frozen Basha fish. According to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs (2020), the national customs has suspended the acceptance of Vietnamese aquatic products manufacturer Branch of Blue Sea Agriculture & Seafood Processing Limited Company in Binh Thuan (Blue Sea Co., LTD) (registered as HK 780) for 9 weeks, and suspended the acceptance of the import declaration of Vietnam aquatic products manufacturer GEPIMEX 404 COMPANY (registered as DL 77) for 4 weeks.



India

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from one product body sample of a batch of frozen South American white shrimp and one outer package sample of a batch of frozen octopus imported from India, according to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs suspended the acceptance of Indian aquatic products manufacturers M/S. Jayalakshmi Seafood PVT.Ltd. (registration number 924) and M/s. Rich Marine Export (registration number 100) from March 3rd.

Indonesia

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from an inner package sample of a batch of frozen squid imported from Indonesia, according to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs suspended accepting the import declaration of Indonesian aquatic products manufacturer PT. AWINDO INTERNATIONAL (registration number: CR 122-12) for one week from March 5th.

Summary of emergency preventive measures in March

Indonesia

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from one outer packaging sample of a batch of frozen sea eels imported from Indonesia, according to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs suspended the import declaration of products from Indonesian aquatic product manufacturer CV. INDO PACIFIC (registration number: CR 121-12) for one week from March 9th.

Pakistan

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from one package sample of one batch of frozen swimming crab and two packages samples of two batches of frozen snail imported from Pakistan. According to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, Since March 9th, the national customs has suspended the acceptance of Pakistani aquatic products manufacturers M/S.B.K Trading Co. (registration number : T-516/G-2018), M/s. Aqua Pearl (registration number : TEC-109/09) and M/s. Three Star Sea Foods (registration number : T-452



Ecuador

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from 8 outer packaging samples of 5 batches of frozen South American white shrimp imported from Ecuador. According to the regulation of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs suspended the import declaration of products from COFIMAR S.A (registration number 7145), ProExpo, Procesador a y exportadora de Mariscos S.A. (registration number 678), two aquatic products manufacturers in Ecuador, for one week. Suspension of the import declaration of Ecuador aquatic product manufacturer Exportadora Total Seafood S.A. (registration number 8503) for six weeks.

Vietnam

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from 4 outer packaging samples and 1 inner packaging sample of 3 batches of frozen Basha fish imported from Vietnam and 1 outer packaging sample of 1 batch of frozen dried squid. According to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs has suspended accepting the import declaration of products from Vietnamese aquatic product manufacturer Cuulong Fish Import-Export Corporation (CLPangafish Corp.) (registration number: DL 714) for one week since March 9th. Suspension of acceptance of import declaration of Vietnamese aquatic product manufacturer Atlantic Seafood Freezing Factory N.V (registration number DL 408) for 4 weeks, Continue to suspend the acceptance of import declaration of Vietnamese aquatic products manufacturer Binh Long Company Limited-Bilofish (registration number: DL 529) until April 28th. Continue to suspend the acceptance of the import declaration of Vietnamese aquatic products manufacturer Branch of Blue Sea Agriculture & Seafood Processing Limited Company in Binh Thuan (Blue Sea Co., Ltd.) (registered as HK 780) until May 27th.

Summary of emergency preventive measures in March

Myanmar

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from a product body sample of a batch of frozen middle-low-finned pomfret imported from Myanmar, according to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs suspended the import declaration of Myanmar aquatic products manufacturer Ocean Pacific Cold Storage (registration number : YGN/116/OS/DOF) for one week from March 12th.

Brazil

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from two outer packaging samples of two batches of frozen boneless beef products imported from Brazil, according to General Administration of Customs Announcement No.103 of 2022, the national customs suspended the import declaration of Brazilian meat producers JBS S.A (registration number: SIF4507) and Valegrande Industria e Comercio de Alimentos S/A (registration number: SIF4490) for one week from March 12th.

Vietnam

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from two outer packaging samples of one batch of frozen big-eyed chicken dried fish imported from Vietnam and three outer packaging samples of two batches of frozen Basha fish. According to Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, Since March 12th, the national customs has suspended the acceptance of export sea products processing enterprise V-baria Vung Tau seafood processing and import-export joint stock company (BAS EAFOOD) (registration number : HK 242), Import declaration for products of cadovimex II Freezing Factory No.1-cadovimex II Seafood Import-Export and Processing Joint Stock Company (registration number : DL 483) for one week, Continue to suspend accepting the import declaration of a Vietnamese aquatic product manufacturer Cuu Long Fish Import-Export Corporation (CLPangafish Corp.) (registration number : DL 714) for one week.

Ecuador

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from an inner package sample of a batch of frozen South American white shrimp imported from Ecuador, according to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs suspended the import declaration of products from Ecuador aquatic product manufacturer Pacfish S.A (registration number: 6807) for one week from March 12th.



Summary of emergency preventive measures in March

Pakistan

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from one outer package sample of one batch of frozen snail products and seven outer package samples of one batch of frozen golden thread fish products imported from Pakistan. According to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, Since March 15th, the national customs has suspended the acceptance of the import declaration of Pakistan aquatic products manufacturer M/s. Pearl Marine International (registered as T-396/2015) for one week and the import declaration of Pakistan aquatic products manufacturer M/S. Qadrinori Enterprises (registered as T-202/011) for four weeks.

Indonesia

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from 4 outer packaging samples of 4 batches of frozen squid imported from Indonesia and 1 outer packaging sample of 1 batch of frozen leucorrhea fish. According to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, Since March 15th, the national customs has suspended the acceptance of CV. SINAR TIRTA (registered as CR 760-16), PT. REMBANG SPORTINDO MANDIRI (registered as CR 687-11), The import declaration of PT. CENHONG FISHERINDO (registration number CR 516-12) was suspended for one week, and the import declaration of CV. JASUMA (registration number : CR 633-11), an Indonesian aquatic product manufacturer, was suspended for two weeks.



India

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from 24 outer packages and 1 product body sample of 15 batches of frozen hairtail imported from India, 4 outer packages and 1 inner package sample of 5 batches of frozen South American white shrimp and 1 outer package sample of 1 batch of frozen shrimp. According to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, Since March 15th, the national customs has suspended the import declaration of products from nine Indian aquatic products manufacturers (registration number : 1206, 1273, 214, 1847, 386, 903, 497, 930, MUM/FFP/02597 respectively) for one week, and suspended the acceptance of five Indian aquatic products manufacturers (registration number : 1201 and 12597 respectively)

Ecuador

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive in 22 outer packaging samples and 1 inner packaging sample of 18 batches of frozen South American white shrimp imported from Ecuador, and 2 outer packaging samples of 1 batch of frozen pomfret. According to Announcement No.103 of the General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs suspended the acceptance of the import declaration of products from eight aquatic products manufacturing enterprises in Ecuador (registration numbers : 51, 684, 4251, 7145, 56, 41068, 548 and 31991, respectively) for one week from March 17th, and suspended the acceptance of products from one aquatic product manufacturing enterprise in Ecuador (registration number : 6792).

Summary of emergency preventive measures in March

India

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from 33 outer packaging samples of 15 batches of frozen hairtail imported from India, 11 outer packaging samples, 1 inner packaging sample and 1 container inner wall sample of 9 batches of frozen South American white shrimp, and 3 outer packaging samples of 2 batches of frozen gooseberry. According to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, Since March 17th, the national customs has suspended the import declaration of products from 13 aquatic products manufacturers in India (registration numbers are 224, 1357, 254, 779, 1195, 1222, 1245, 1239, 480, 920, 1340, 259 and 459 respectively) for one week, and suspended the acceptance of one aquatic product manufacturer in India. Continue to suspend the acceptance of the product import declaration of an Indian aquatic product manufacturer (registration number : 1273) for 9 weeks, continue to suspend the acceptance of the product import declaration of an Indian aquatic product manufacturer (registration number : 1290) for 12 weeks and suspend the acceptance of the product import declaration of an Indian aquatic product manufacturer (registration number : 1241) for 14 weeks.



India

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from 4 batches of frozen South American white shrimp imported from India, 3 samples of outer package and 1 sample of inner container wall, 2 batches of frozen hairtail, 3 samples of outer package of 2 batches of frozen cuttlefish, 2 samples of outer package and 1 sample of product body, 1 sample of outer package of 1 batch of frozen squid, 1 sample of outer package and 1 sample of product body of 1 batch of frozen tongue sole, and 1 sample of outer package of 1 batch of frozen eel. According to the provisions of the announcement No.103 of the General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs has suspended the import declaration of products from seven aquatic product manufacturing enterprises in India (registration numbers : 1280, 857, 1503, 930, 496, 1234 and 1245) for one week from March 23; Suspending the application for import of products from an aquatic product manufacturer (registration number : 1164) in India for 4 weeks; Continuing to suspend the acceptance of the product import declaration of an aquatic product manufacturer (registration number : 1290) in India for 4 weeks; Continuing to suspend the application for import of products from an aquatic product manufacturer (registration number : 259) in India for 5 weeks; Continuing to suspend the application for import of products from an Indian water product manufacturer (registration number : 1241) for 8 weeks.

Summary of emergency preventive measures in March

Pakistan

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from 1 package sample of 1 batch of frozen snails, 3 packages samples of 1 batch of frozen hairtail and 1 package sample of 1 batch of frozen octopus imported from Pakistan, in accordance with the provisions of General Administration of Customs Announcement No.103 of 2020, Since March 23, the national customs has suspended the acceptance of the product import declaration of two Pakistani aquatic product manufacturers, M/s. J&D FOODS ENTERPRISES (registration number : T-544/D-19) and M/s. Hamna Fisheries (registration number : T-225/2011), for one week, and continued to suspend the acceptance of the product import declaration of one Pakistani aquatic product manufacturer, M/s. Super Star Enterprises (registration number : TEC-45/91), for one week.

Vietnam

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from one package sample of one batch of frozen bigeye chicken and dried fish from eight packages samples of four batches of frozen barracuda fish imported from Vietnam. In accordance with the provisions of General Administration of Customs Announcement No.103 of 2020, the national customs has suspended the acceptance of Investment Commerce Fisheries Corporation-Incom Fish Corporation, two aquatic product manufacturers in Vietnam, from March 22. One week of product import declaration for Seafood & Foodstuffs Processing Factory No.5 (registration number HK 187) and HUNGCA 6 CORPORATION (HUNGCA 6) (registration number : DL 676). Suspension of product import declaration for one Vietnamese aquatic product manufacturer, Godaco Bentre (registered as DL 541), for 9 weeks.



Ecuador

As Covid-19 nucleic acid was positive from 14 outer packaging samples and 2 inner packaging samples of 11 batches of frozen South American white shrimp imported from Ecuador. According to the provisions of Announcement No.103 of General Administration of Customs in 2020, the national customs has suspended accepting the import declaration of EMPACRECI (registration number: 681), an aquatic product manufacturer in Ecuador, for 4 weeks since March 22nd. Continue to suspend the acceptance of import declarations of products from two aquatic products manufacturers in Ecuador, Opera Dora y Procesador a de Productos Marinos Omar sa S.A. (registration number : 41068) and Export Dora Total Seafood S.A. (registration number : 8503) for 20 weeks.

Category	Announcement No.	Comments
Animal and plant product supervision	Department of Animal and Plant Quarantine of General Administration of Customs [No.12 [2022] of Animal Planting Letter]	Announcement on suspending the import of Lithuanian logs. The customs has repeatedly detected harmful organisms from imported Lithuanian logs, suspended the import according to relevant regulations, and notified the competent Lithuanian authorities. Since February 26th, 2022, the Customs has suspended the acceptance of Lithuanian log declaration.
	Announcement No.21 of General Administration of Customs in 2022	Announcement on allowing wheat import throughout Russia. This announcement is a supplement to the original General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine Announcement No.25, 2018 (requirements for inspection and quarantine of imported Russian wheat and Hungarian corn plants). Expand the permitted Russian producing areas from six to all parts of Russia. The explicitly admitted Russian wheat refers to the spring wheat which is planted in the areas of the Russian Federation where there is no dwarf smut of wheat, and is only used for processing. Provisions have been made for wheat export inspection and quarantine, transportation epidemic prevention and plant quarantine certificates.
	Announcement of Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs of General Administration of Customs No.20, 2022	Announcement on preventing the introduction of highly pathogenic avian influenza in Canada into China. Since February 21st, 2022, it is forbidden to import poultry and related products directly or indirectly from Canada, including unprocessed or processed poultry products that may still spread diseases. Once found, all poultry products will be returned or destroyed. Stop issuing the Entry Animal and Plant Quarantine Permit for importing poultry and related products from Canada, and revoke the Entry Animal and Plant Quarantine Permit that has been issued within the validity period.
	Announcement No.19 of General Administration of Customs in 2022	Announcement on quarantine requirements of corn plants imported from Myanmar. From February 18th, 2022, Myanmar corn that meets relevant requirements will be allowed to be imported. The allowed corn must be produced all over Myanmar and exported to China for processing, not for planting. The announcement regulates the list of quarantine pests, pre-shipment requirements, entry inspection and quarantine, etc.
Administrative approval	Announcement No.25 of General Administration of Customs in 2022	Announcement on issuing 86 industry standards such as Inspection Regulations for Imported Recycled Copper Raw Materials and abolishing 3 industry standards. The 86 industry standards announced this time will be officially implemented on October 1st, 2022. On March 14th, 2022, three industry standards were abolished.

Animal and plant product supervision	Announcement No.18 of General Administration of Customs in 2022	Announcement on inspection and quarantine requirements for imported Chilean beef. From February 17th, 2022, Chilean beef that meets relevant requirements will be allowed to be imported. Beef allowed to be exported to China must be born, raised and slaughtered in Chile. Import and export control	Announcement No.1 of the State Tobacco Monopoly Bureau in 2022	On further strengthening the supervision of new tobacco products such as electronic cigarettes. The announcement will be implemented on May 1, 2022. The announcement requires that enterprises that already hold the license of tobacco monopoly wholesale enterprises can only engage in the import and wholesale business of electronic cigarettes and other products after changing the license scope with the approval of the department of tobacco monopoly administration under the State Council. Import of electronic cigarette products, atomized products and nicotine for electronic cigarettes shall report the demand to the department of tobacco monopoly administration under the State Council, and comply with relevant state regulations. Imported e-cigarette products, aerosols and nicotine for e-cigarettes shall be sold to e-cigarette wholesale enterprises, e-cigarette product manufacturers and e-cigarette brand holders through the e-cigarette trading management platform stipulated in the Measures for the Administration of E-cigarettes. Imported electronic cigarette products sold in China shall pass the technical review and use the trademark approved and registered in China.
Customs clearance	Announcement No.24 of General Administration of Customs in 2022	Announcement on clarifying matters related to declaration of corpses before entry into China. It is clearly required that the shipper or his agent declare to the customs at the port of entry before the bodies and bones are shipped overseas.
	Announcement No.26 of General Administration of Customs in 2022	Announcement on the publication of the List of Customs Inspection and Quarantine Names and Commodity Numbers for Special Goods) There are 195 CIQ codes for products under the supervision of special goods this time, and special goods approval forms or non-special goods declaration documents are required when applying for products in the special goods list.
